Dr. B K Goyal is an internationally acclaimed interventional cardiologist & medical educationist. He is practising as a cardiologist at Bombay Hospital since 1966. Dr. Goyal is the only cardiologist outside the United States to have the unique distinction of being appointed as the hony.consultant cardiologist to the world famous Texas Heart Institute, Houston.

Dr. Goyal is the Hony.Director Medical Education & Research & Chief Cardiologist at the Bombay Hospital Institute of Medical Sciences (1985 – 2009) and former Director-Professor of Cardiology of J J Group of Hospitals and Grant Medical College, Mumbai, which he served in an honorary capacity for 25 years.

He is the hony. consultant cardiologist to the Armed Forces of India, a visiting Professor of Cardiology at the University of Alabama in U.S. and visiting cardiologist to the Oshner Heart Institute, New Orleans. The State Government honoured him by appointing him as the Professor Emeritus of Cardiology for life. He was the member of executive council of the University of Bombay and presently is the Member of the senate of Maharashtra University of Health Sciences (MUHS). He has served as a member of the Central Council of Health and Family Welfare and National Council for blood transfusion.

Dr. Goyal was the hony chairman of the renowned Haffkine Institute at Mumbai for fourteen years and under his stewardship the institute successfully developed indigenous polio vaccines which was duly approved by WHO for the first time in the country.

He has been mainly responsible for the establishment of Bombay Hospital Institute of Medical Sciences, a post-graduate medical institute imparting high grade medical education in various specialities and super-specialities.

In recognition of the public service rendered by him he was appointed as the Hon. Sheriff of Bombay in 1980. He was conferred Padma Shri in 1984, Padma Bhushan in 1989 and Padma Vibhushan in 2005. He has presided over various international conferences in cardiology and is the recipient of many national and international awards. He has been invited to deliver several prestigious orations. He has around 50 publications in national and international journals.

He was elected as the youngest President of Cardiological Society of India, Association of Physicians of India, National Society for Prevention of Heart Disease and American College of Chest Physicians. Dr. Goyal is also the founder president of Indo-American Society of Cardiology. He is the founder president of Heart Foundation of India and Indian College of Interventional Cardiology. He was the leader of the national delegation of cardiologists to Argentina and Rome.

He has been connected with the Indian Council of Medical Research, WHO and the Union Public Service Commission. He was conferred Purandare Award by the Indian Medical Association and Nanda International Award for his outstanding contribution in the field of cardiology.

He has been served as "Editor" of world's foremost cardiology journal, Journal of American College of Cardiology (JACC), South East Asia Edition.

He has been invited as a International Faculty at TCT 2005, 2012, 2013 and 2014 and also on the Faculty of Joint Interventional Meeting (JIM), Rome in 2003, 2004, 2005, 2006, 2007, 2008 & 2009 and Complex Cardiovascular Therapeutics (CCT)

in Japan, 2009. He has also been invited as Faculty to the The Great Wall International Conference on Cardiology at Beijing, China, in 2007 and at Live Symposium Complex Coronary & Cardiovascular Cases' held at Mount Sinai Hospital, New York in 2008, 2009, 2010, 2011, 2012, 2013 and 2014.

He is also designated as 'National Professor' by the Academy of Medical Sciences. He has the honour to serve as the Member of MCI & PG Committee of MCI.

He was invited to inaugurate the international conference 'Vascular Interventions 2004' at Cairo, Egypt and Intercontinental Interventional Summit at Dubai. He has presided the 2nd World Congress of Interventional Cardiology in 2005 and Indo-Pak Summit on Angioplasty in 2006 and will preside over International Congress on Interventional Cardiology in April 2009 at Zurich.

He was felicitated by Catholic Medical Centre, a group of 17 teaching hospitals in New York, USA, as an exceptionally distinguished medical man who has contributed immensely to the growth of cardiology and medical education in US and India.

He was among the nine distinguished Indians from different walks of life who were decorated with Scroll of Honour during 150th year celebrations of the University of Mumbai by President of India.

Dr. Goyal was felicitated with Global Award for outstanding contribution in the field of Cardiology by prestigious Priyadarshni Academy. He was also the Vice-Chairman of Indian Red Cross Society Headquarters at Delhi for five years.

He has been invited as the Member on the Editorial Board of the Catheterization and Cardiovascular Interventions (USA), an official Journal of The Society for Cardiovascular Angiography and Interventions.

He has served as the Visitor's Nominee of the Banaras Hindu University and Delhi University. He has been appointed as Member of the Governing Body of Jawaharlal Institute of Post Graduate Medical Education and Research (JIPMER),

Pondicherry, by Government of India. He was the Chief Guest to deliver the convocation address at the Convocation of Maharashtra University of Health Sciences.

He was also presented “Master Teacher - 2009” award by The Association of Physicians of India (API) in January 2010. He was presented with “THE LIFE TIME ACHIEVEMENT AWARD” by Dr. Jack Lewin, CEO of American College of Cardiology, USA, during the Indo European Congress of Cardiology held at the Academic Medical Centre, Amsterdam, Holland, in recognition of his contribution to the field of angioplasty.

He has been invited as Faculty at China Interventional Therapeutics - CIT 2011 at Beijing, China. He has been honoured with ‘Life Time Achivememnt Award” by the Association of Physicians of India in October 2011 and Cardiological Society of India in 2012.

He has also been nominated as a Member of Management Council of Maharashtra University of Health Sciences (MUHS) Nashik.

Recently, he has been honoured with the ‘Life Achievement Award’ towards the contribution to the growth, welfare and service of the country by Union Bank of India as a part of Bank’s Foundation Day celebration.
